Data protection declaration OELCHECK app

General information

The following information provides a simple overview of what happens to your personal data when you visit our app.

Definition of personal data: All data with which you can be personally identified. You can find detailed information on the subject of data protection in our data protection declaration below.

1) Name and contact details

This data protection information applies to data processing when using our OELCHECK app.

2) Permissions of the OELCHECK app

OELCHECK requires the following authorizations from you:

1. INTERNET (retrieve data from the Internet / access to all networks):

Is required to load the samples or machine data.

2. ACCESS FINE LOCATION (exact location):

This enables machines to be displayed in the vicinity.

The authorization system corresponds to the rights of Android and iOS.

For iOS and Android, you are explicitly asked for consent to certain rights so that you can make a decision here.

3) Use of location data

In our app, you have the option of automatically recognizing the wind turbine in question based on your location, which makes it easier to collect the data.

The location data (e.g. display of the current position) is usually used on your mobile device. The accuracy is limited to 3-5 meters. This data is only used to record the wind turbine.

To use the location services, they must be activated in your mobile operating system. As soon as these are activated and the app is started for the first time, access to the location information is requested. The confirmation means that the app is allowed to access your location information.

You can deactivate the access of the respective app to your location in the settings of your mobile device.

4) Evaluation of usage data

Anonymised usage data is evaluated for the safe operation and further development of the OELCHECK app. However, this data cannot be linked to your identity. We have no way of assigning this data to you and we do not combine this data with other data sources.

When using the OELCHECK app, data is saved in a log file for statistical and backup purposes.

We only collect the following data for a period of one month:

- Name of the file accessed
- · Date and time of access
- · Amount of data transferred
- Report whether the retrieval was successful
- If access is successful: anonymized IP address of the accessing host system
- If the request is unsuccessful, the complete IP address is saved for the purpose of troubleshooting and security

5) Google Analytics for Firebase and Firebase Crashlytics

The OELCHECK app optionally uses Google Analytics for Firebase and Firebase Crashlytics.

The information generated about the use of the OELCHECK app is transmitted with an anonymized IP address to a Google server in the USA and stored there. The IP anonymization function in Analytics sets the last octet for IPv4 user IP addresses and the last 80 bits in memory for IPv6 addresses. As a result, the exact IP address of the user is not saved.

Google will use this information to evaluate your use of the OELCHECK app in order to compile reports on the activity for the app operators. Google may also transfer this information to third parties. If the user agrees to the use of Google Analytics for Firebase and Firebase Crashlytics in the OELCHECK app, he declares his consent to the processing of the data collected about him by Google in the manner described above and for the aforementioned purpose.

This usage data forms the basis for statistical, anonymous evaluations, so that trends can be identified, on the basis of which the offer can be improved accordingly.

The integration takes place on the basis of your express consent acc. Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 lit. a and Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 lit. f GDPR. It is done to make our application more user-friendly and interesting. This is a legitimate interest in the sense of the aforementioned regulation.

6) Disclosure of data to third parties

Data that has been logged when using the OELCHECK app is generally only passed on to third parties if this is required by law, determined by a court decision or the disclosure is necessary for legal or criminal prosecution in the event of attacks on the DWD internet infrastructure. It will not be passed on for other non-commercial or commercial purposes.

7) Rights of data subjects

You have the right:

- to revoke your consent given to us at any time in accordance with Art. 7 Para. 3 GDPR. As a result, we can no longer continue the data processing based on this consent in the future;
- to request information about your personal data processed by us in accordance with Art. 15 GDPR. In particular, you can obtain information about the processing purposes, the category of personal data, the categories of recipients to whom your data has been or will be disclosed, the planned storage period, the existence of a right to correction, deletion, restriction of processing or opposition, the existence of a Right to lodge a complaint, request the origin of your data, unless it was collected from us;
- According to Art. 16 GDPR, to immediately request the correction of incorrect or incomplete personal data stored by us
- to request the deletion of your personal data stored by us, in accordance with Art. 17 GDPR, unless the processing for exercising the right to freedom of expression and information, for fulfilling a legal obligation, for reasons of public interest or for asserting, exercising or defending Legal claims is required;
- To request the restriction of the processing of your personal data in accordance with Art. 18 GDPR, provided that the accuracy of the data is disputed by you, the processing is unlawful, but you refuse to delete it and we no longer need the data, but you need this to assert, You need to exercise or defend legal claims or you have objected to processing in accordance with Art. 21 GDPR;
- according to Art. 20 GDPR, to receive your personal data, which you have provided to us, in a structured, common and machine-readable format or to request the transmission to another person responsible and
- to complain to a supervisory authority in accordance with Art. 77 GDPR. As a rule, you can contact the supervisory authority of your usual place of residence or work or our company headquarters.
- Information about your right to object according to Art. 21 GDPR

You have the right, for reasons that arise from your particular situation, at any time against the processing of your personal data, which is based on Article 6 Paragraph 1 Sentence 1 lit. e GDPR (data processing in the public interest) and Article 6 (1) sentence 1 lit. f GDPR (data processing on the basis of a balance of interests) takes place to object.

If you file an objection, we will no longer process your personal data, unless we can demonstrate compelling legitimate reasons for the processing that outweigh your interests, rights and freedoms, or the processing serves to assert, exercise or defend legal claims.

If your objection is directed against the processing of data for the purpose of direct advertising, we will stop processing immediately. In this case, it is not necessary to specify a special situation.
